How do school-based health centers benefit students, staff, and the school communities they serve?

- By helping students and staff stay in school when they would otherwise have to leave campus to receive needed care
- By helping improve students' academic achievement by taking care of health needs that can make learning difficult
- By serving students who otherwise might not receive care for reasons like lack of transportation or insurance
- By supporting school staff through wellness events, education on student health, and technical assistance (like classroom guest speakers)



What is a school-based health clinic?

- A school-based health center is an on-campus clinic that allows students and staff to be seen by medical professionals during school without having to miss hours or even an entire day. It's especially helpful to parents who will not have to leave work for an appointment.



Will a student visit the Wolves Health Clinic without parent/guardian permission?

- No. Parents/guardians will be contacted by the school nurse before an appointment is made at the Wolves Health Clinic.



What services will be provided at the Wolves Health Clinic?

- Healthstar Physicians of Hot Springs will staff and run the Wolves Health Clinic and can provide the following types of care:
 - Primary Care for Illness and Injury
 - Comprehensive Annual Exams
 - Laboratory Tests
 - Prescription Medications
 - Nutrition Education and Weight Management
 - Health Education, Counseling, and Wellness Promotion
 - Referrals for Services Not Provided



How will prescriptions work?

- No one will leave the clinic with medication or a written prescription. All prescriptions will be called into the pharmacy of choice for the student or staff member.



The student or staff member already has a primary care provider (PCP), can they still be seen at the Wolves Health Clinic?

- Yes. However, some insurances do require a referral that will be needed before you can be seen. The intent of the clinic is not to change a current PCP, it is to meet the needs of staff and students on campus.

- Yes. Healthstar will bill your insurance. All students and staff will receive a discount.



What if my student does not have health insurance?

- If your child does not have health insurance, Healthstar can assist in getting the child setup with ARKids.



Who can be seen at the Wolves Health Clinic?

- A Healthstar provider will be onsite to see students and staff of the Lake Hamilton School District.



What are the operating hours for the Wolves Health Clinic?

- The hours of operation will be released once a grand opening date has been announced, along with any required registration paperwork for students and staff.
