At Lake Hamilton High School, we share a responsibility for ensuring your child is on track for college and career readiness. We recognize that students need help aligning their interests and abilities with career pathways and that knowing academic strengths and weaknesses can help guide them as they prepare for their futures.

This year, we've chosen to administer the PreACT® as one of the first actionable steps your sophomore can take to become ready for college and plan for the future. With PreACT®, you can get useful information to help your child choose the right high school courses, think about ways to work on areas for improvement, and even begin discussions about their college and career interests.

At no cost to you, we are providing your child with the PreACT on Wednesday, September 30, from approximately 8:00-11:30 AM at the high school. Please plan to drop your virtual student off behind at the high school at 8:00 AM and to pick them up from the same location at approximately 11:30 AM. They don't have to bring anything with them except a water bottle and snack if they desire.
